TAHOE CITY PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT BOARD SEATS UP FOR ELECTION

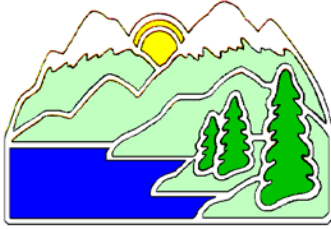
Tahoe City, CA – July 6, 2016 –

The Tahoe City Public Utility District (“District”) will be conducting a consolidated general election with the Placer County Elections Department on November 8, 2016. There will be 3 Board Member seats up for election.

The District is governed by a 5-member Board, elected by popular vote of the general public who reside within the District boundaries. Each Board Member serves a 4-year term and anyone interested in running for a seat on the Board must be a registered voter within the District. Board Members receive District medical, dental and vision benefits and in accordance with Section 16002 of the Public Utility District Act, also receive a \$400 per month stipend. Board Meetings are held on the 3rd Friday of the month at 8:30 a.m. in the District Board Room located at 221 Fairway Drive, Tahoe City.

The filing period begins on Monday, July 18, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. and ends on August 12, 2016, at 5:00 p.m. If an incumbent fails to file for their term by the last day of the filing period, the time will be extended 5 days, ending Wednesday, August 17, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. Please be advised that this extension **DOES NOT APPLY** if there is not an eligible incumbent to be elected – **the incumbent may not file after August 12, 2016.**

If you reside in Placer County and wish to run for a board seat, Declaration of Candidacy papers are available at the Customs House Building located at 775 North Lake Blvd., Tahoe City. If you reside in El Dorado County, appointments may be made for either July 21st or August 4th at the Recorder Clerks Office at 3368 Lake Tahoe Blvd. #108, South Lake Tahoe, CA 96150, or any other business day between 8:00 am – 5:00 pm at the Recorder-Clerk’s Office, 360 Fair Lane, Placerville, CA 95667.
